

INTERNATIONAL
COMPETITION**TALL EMBLEM STRUCTURE FOR ZA'ABEEL PARK IN DUBAI**

Dubai Municipality and ThyssenKrupp Elevator announce the launch of a **International, open, single stage, public, anonymous, preliminary design competition** for the conception of a tall emblem structure, to promote the new face of Dubai.



In conformity with the UIA-UNESCO regulations for international competitions, the **competition has been approved by the UIA.**

Located within the **Za'abeel Park** the structure should **promote tourism, have a unique state of the art design, include cultural and leisure activities, conference and theatre facilities.** Local climatic conditions should be taken into account, as well as urban and landscape aspects, passive construction principles should be applied and the structure should respond to the seismic constraints of the region.

The following prizes will be awarded: a first prize of **100 000US \$**, a second of **50 000US \$** in addition to three prizes of **20 000 US \$** each.
