This award is in recognition of buildings recently completed or un-built in the civic buildings sector: museums, theatres, police stations or any other public buildings, constructed over the last three years (since 1 January 2007).

Architect Eva Jiricna will be the UIA repersentative on the jury.

Submission deadline for the Civic Buildings award sector is 30 June 2010.
