Dear Sir/Madam,

On May 10, 2010, the Council of Ministers for Education, Youth and Culture of the European Union approved Riga as the European capital of culture 2014. That imposes certain responsibility on the administration of Riga city and it is also a unique opportunity for the city to show its achievements in the field of culture.

One of the central cultural objects of Riga is the Latvian National Museum of Art and its task is to educate society, arouse public interest in the evidence of visual art, decorative art and design of Latvia and the world in their historical and artistic manifestations by emphasizing the role of the national school of art in cultural history and contemporary processes. The national architectural monument – a building of the Latvian National Museum of Art in Riga, which is located in the center of Riga and is one of the most representative buildings in the Boulevard Circle. As a result, architects should find a solution for functioning of the museum in the future by preserving and restoring it as a significant architectural monument and meanwhile finding a solution for expansion of the premises so that the extension organically integrated into the cultural history environment, and provide new value added to the particular place.

Riga City Council invites architects, town planners, landscape architects, designers and restorers to take part in the international Sketch Competition on "Renovation and Extension Project Development of the Latvian National Museum of Art Building in Riga, Kr.Valdemāra Street 10a".
