EUROPEAN PRIME PROPERTY AWARD

The deadline for submitting projects to the 2012 edition of the European Prime Property Award is 15 December 2011.

The award is open to architects and urban planners in collaboration with investors and promoters, and this year's awards will recompense projects realised between 2006 and 2011. The realisations must have a minimum surface area of 5000 m2, and may be new constructions or reconversions, situated in a European country. A total of 30 000 euro in prize money will be awarded: 1st prize - 15 000 euro, 2nd prize - 10 000 euro, 3rd prize - 5 000 euro.


AUSTRALIA INSPIRE
