
Note: You are required to fill in an or<u>iginal visa application form. F</u>orms downloaded off the Internet will not be accepted.

If you are subject to visa requirements, you should apply for your visa at least four weeks before your departure for South Africa. Do not leave until you know your application has been successful. Visas are not issued at South African ports of entry, and airline officials are obliged to insist on visas before allowing passengers to board.
