The subject of the competition is the urban planning and transport solution for a new main rail station in Brno, situated in the locality below Petrov Hill, and simultaneously the formulation of a strategy for the emergence of a viable urban district corresponding to the needs and realities of the 21st and 22nd centuries.

This competition approaches the development area in the centre of Brno as an opportunity for a new reconceptualising of the city. The competition seeks a differing view of this locality than simply the pragmatic installation of high-rise structures, or the creation of an internal periphery. The goal is to find a solution that will be resilient, adaptable, sustainable, and aesthetically satisfying, whether from the standpoints of architecture, urban planning, or transport. The task that the competition presents to architects and other experts is the design of a process that should be initiated by the city itself and should lead to the formation of a fully valid and integral section of a modern European city.
